Patricia Ann Fisk, 57, of Coldwater, died unexpectedly on Monday, October 8, 2018 at Borgess Medical Center in Kalamazoo.

A memorial service will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Saturday, October 13, 2018 at the United Methodist Church in Coldwater. Interment will be at 3:00 P.M. on Saturday, October 13, 2018 at Sherwood Cemetery. The family is being served by Lighthouse Funeral & Cremation in Union City.

Patricia was born on March 18, 1961 in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan. She was raised by Tom Moore and Sophia “Jenny” Gordon. She married Terry Fisk and they had two sons together. The couple divorced after 12 years of marriage. Patricia lived in Union City until the late 1990s and then moved to Coldwater where she has lived since. She was engaged to Daniel Rivera of Coldwater and they had planned to be married the Friday before she died.

Ms. Fisk had worked at the corner café in Union City, which went by several names through the years. She later worked at the Bob Evans Restaurant in Coldwater and managed Anna’s Adult Foster Care on North Hudson Street in Coldwater. Patricia was known for her jewelry collection and she loved to give pieces to her friends and family. She was a wonderful mother to her sons and was always very involved in their lives. She had a great sense of humor and always put others needs ahead of her own. She will be remembered as being a selfless and generous woman who was loved by many.
