Shirley Jean Morley, 81, of Union City, passed away on Sunday, March 29, 2020 at Manatee Hospital, Bradenton, Florida, after a short illness with family by her side.

A public graveside service will be held at 2:30 PM on Sunday, June 28, 2020 at Burlington Township Cemetery with Rachel Labram from Marshall United Methodist Church officiating. The family is being served by Lighthouse Funeral & Cremation of Union City.

Shirley was born May 22, 1938 in Coldwater to Zonald and Mary Clark. She graduated in 1956 from Tekonsha High School and married Paul Morley on June 23, 1956. They spent 50 years together in marriage until Paul's death October 19, 2006.

Shirley loved her family much and always wanted to see them happy and well. Shirley was a longtime member of the Moose Lodge and was an avid bowler when she was younger.
